## Minor Clarification

- In the DEIR Table 3.6-4, the column heading appears to be mislabeled. The table and section refer to bicycle traffic volumes, but the third column heading is labeled as "Westbound (WB) Daily Pedestrian Volume Counts".
- In Appendix A of the Traffic Impact Study (Appendix D), page 118 on the "Morrison\_Canyon\_DEIR\_Appendicies\_Combined.pdf" the footnote for Intersection 6 appears to be labeled incorrectly. Please confirm whether it should be "Morrison Canyon Road Safety Project" instead of "Niles Gateway Environmental Impact Analysis". Also, on the same page, confirm whether the footnote should be "PM Existing plus Project" instead of "PM Existing".
