The Project would permanently close an approximately 0.8-mile stretch of middle Morrison Canyon Road to private motor vehicles. The affected area currently is subject to a temporary road closure, which has been in place since November 2018. The temporary closure, which includes barricades and signage, indicating the roadway access restrictions, limits access to private motor vehicles but also allows continued access for emergency vehicles, emergency access for local residents within the rural hillside area, and non-vehicular uses (pedestrian and bicycle). The closure is achieved through the use of flexible plastic barricades with a hinged base that can be mounted by most motor vehicles and navigated by pedestrians and bicyclists.
