Project Title: Drainage Realignment at 8015 Carrisa Highway (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-1004-R4)

Project Location: The Project will occur within and adjacent to two unnamed tributaries to Soda Lake located at 8015 Carrisa Highway, Santa Margarita, approximately 13 miles northwest of Soda Lake in San Luis Obispo, State of California; Section 25, Township 29 South, Range 17 East, and Section 30, Township 29 South, Range 18 East, United States Geological Survey 7.5 Minute Quad Map California Valley, MDB&M; Latitude 35.369936 North, Longitude -120.094602 West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-1004-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Tim Wendorff.

The Project includes the rerouting of two streams into one channel around the current and future proposed cannabis cultivation facilities on site and construction of a stream crossing composed of cobble.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 8/3/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
