Project Title: State Route 217 San Jose Creek Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SBA-18681-R5)

Project Location (Santa Barbara County): The project is located on State Route 217 where it crosses San Jose Creek; Latitude 34.420797, Longitude -119.829759.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SBA-18681-R5), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The project is limited to replacing the San Jose Creek Bridge on State Route 217, reconstructing the bridge approaches, and realigning the multiuse path. The 7-span bridge will be replaced with a 2-span bridge, which will reduce the number of columns in San Jose Creek. This project will also include realigning the multi-use path and a small roadside, vegetated drainage to accommodate the higher bridge profile.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on May 27, 2022, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
