Project Title: Coldstream Canyon Restoration Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-33494-R2)

Project Location: The project is located in Cold Creek, a tributary to Donner Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 39.292358, Longitude -121. 270800; Assessor's Parcel Number 069-190-048-000. The Project area is an approximately one-mile reach located approximately six miles southwest of the Town of Truckee.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-33494-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Truckee River Watershed Council, as represented by Eben Swain.

The project is limited to excavation, floodplain widening, bank softening and the creation of floodplain terraces, bank stabilization (i.e., log and boulder revetments, log roughness structures, groins, and barbs), full channel fill, installation of reinforced riffle grade controls and boulder weirs in a boulder step pool alignment.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement for the project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
