**Project Title:** Warm Creek Routine Maintenance Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0217-R6 Revision 1)

**Project Location:** The project is located within Warm Creek approximately 0.8 mile east of Interstate 215, between Sierra Way and Mill Street, in the City of San Bernardino, San Bernardino County, State of California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0217-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of San Bernardino. The project consists of on-going maintenance within Warm Creek. The maintenance activities covered under this Agreement include two distinct "maintenance projects", as follows:

1. Vegetation Management – vegetation management includes trimming and removal of vegetation using non-motorized hand tools, mechanical vegetation cutters, shredders, string trimmers, chainsaws, mowing, and excavation; and
2. Bank Erosion Control – repair of bank erosion with ungrouted rock, totaling no more than 0.05-acre.
