Title: RTI Infrastructure, Inc. Grover Beach Subsea Fiber Optic Cables Project

Applicant: Applicant/Sublessor: Middle Mile Infrastructure, LLC; Sublessees: RTI Infrastructure, Inc. and Seren Juno Network America, Inc.

Location: Sovereign tide and submerged land in the Pacific Ocean, near Pismo State Beach, Grover Beach, San Luis Obispo County

Description: Installation and use of a segment of the "Juno Cable" through landing pipe 4. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 24-years, 7 months, and 23 days General Lease – Right-of-Way Use through February 25, 2048, and associated endorsement of sublease.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 26, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.
