Project Title: New River Improvement Project-Calexico Reach (EPIMS\_IMP\_19697\_R6)

Project Location (include county): The project is located on the south side of the New River tributary to the Salton Sea, from about 800 feet northwest of the United States (US)-Mexico International Boundary to about 300 feet east of the All-American Canal Siphon over the New River, within the City of Calexico, in the County of Imperial, State of California; Latitude 32.6706110 N, Longitude 115.5126640 W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS\_IMP\_19697\_R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Calexico.

The project is limited to the installation of temporary coffer dams to isolate a work area within the New River, installation of a trash screen and water diversion structure downstream from the US-Mexico Border, installation of approximately 8,100 feet of 72-inch underground bypass pipe to convey polluted New River water from the diversion structure, around downtown Calexico for approximately 1.5 miles, to the bypass pipe outlet, installation of a 350 square-foot energy dissipater with adjacent riprap at the outlet of the bypass pipe to control erosion, and building a pump-back system to replace the polluted water in the river channel with clean, treated wastewater from the Calexico Wastewater Treatment Plant.
