**Project Title:** Mammoth Bar Motocross Track Relocation (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0190-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The Mammoth Bar Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Area is part of the Auburn State Recreation Area. The project is located at the Middle Fork American River, in the County of Placer, State of California. The project site is approximately located at the following geographic coordinates (WGS84 datum, decimal degrees): latitude 38.919181, longitude -121.003008.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0190-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Parks and Recreation.

High flows on the Middle Fork in January and February of 2017 caused significant erosion to the motocross track. The high flows eroded approximately 0.8 acres of the western portion of the track. The proposed project involves pulling the motocross track area back from the river to an existing parking/picnic and trials area, reducing the chances of flood damage in the future. The project is expected to begin implementation (weather/soil condition permitting) in the summer of 2021. The work is anticipated to take approximately 12 weeks to complete.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
