A Use Permit application for the expansion of an existing twenty (20) truck and fifty (50) trailer truck terminal to include parking for for a maximum of fifty (50) total trucks and (160) total trailers and to expand the existing storm water retention pond. The project site includes a 3,750 square foot truck maintenance shop, and fueling island, and a 2,100 square foot office. This application does not propose the construction of any new buildings. The project site will continue to be served by a well for water, septic system for sewage disposal, and an on-site retention basin for storm drainage facilities. This parcel is not under a Williamson Act contract.
