DOCUMENT TITLE: Flow Equalization & Resource Recovery Facility Levee Improvements & Bayfront Recycled Water Facility Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: The Project is located in Menlo Park, San Mateo County. The Project will occur at the West Bay Sanitary District's Flow Equalization and Resource Recovery Facility site, at 1700 Marsh Road (APN 055-400-101). The Project will also occur at the entrance to Bedwell Bayfront Park and in existing street rights-of-way.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board is funding the Project referred to internally as Bayfront Recycled Water Facility. The Project includes the construction of an influent pump station to divert wastewater from the West Bay Sanitary District collection system, approximately 4,000 linear feet (LF) of influent pipeline, a satellite Membrane Bioreactor/Ultraviolet treatment facility, and a recycled water distribution system. The recycled water distribution system includes a recycled water storage tank, recycled water pump station, and approximately 14,500 LF of distribution pipeline. The Project scope also includes the construction of an ecotone levee, but this portion of the Project is not being funded by the CWSRF Program.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has considered the Environmental Impact Report as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved funding for the Project described above on June 27, 2024. The West Bay Sanitary District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is

limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

2. A Environmental Impact Report was prepared and certified for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15091.
