Project Location: The project is located at Cache Creek, in the County of Yolo County, State of California; Latitude 38.890217 N, Longitude -121.238420 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees) or Section 18, Township 12N, Range 3W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Rumsey, (MDBM), The bridge is located 340 feet northeast of State Route 16; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 060-230-003, 060-230-004, 060-230-006, 060-251-001, 060-230-005, and 060-230-007.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-39556-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Yolo County Department of Community Services as represented by Todd Riddiough.

The project is limited to the construction of a new 400-foot-long, three span, cast-in-place, prestressed concrete box girder structure bridge with 28 feet of clear width between concrete barriers, a 28-foot wide 220-foot southern roadway approach, 620-foot-long northern roadway approach, consisting of two 12-foot lanes with 6-foot shoulders.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
