PROJECT LOCATION: Avenue 54 along Shady Lane, and within the Shady Lane Mobile Home Park in Riverside County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Shady Lane Mobile Home Park Water Consolidation Project. The Project will construct approximately 2,880 linear feet of pipeline to connect the Shady Lane Mobile Home Park to the Coachella Water Authority's municipal water system to provide water system reliability. The Project also includes less than 300 feet of 1-inch on-site lateral pipelines, and new service to provide fire flow in accordance with the Riverside County Ordinance 787 and the 2019 California Fire Code.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on August 16, 2024 and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The City of Coachella will be carrying out the Project.

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION STATUS:

Class 3: New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures

(California Code of Regulations, title 14, division 6, chapter 3, article 19, section 15303)

REASON WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The Project has been determined to meet the requirements of the exemption selected above and will not have a significant impact on water quality. The Project involves the extension of the Coachella Water Authority water system into Shady Lane Mobile Home Park with the installation of 2,880 linear feet

(0.545 miles) of potable water pipelines and less than 300 feet of 1-inch on-site lateral pipelines.
