Title: East Las Palmas Avenue Bridge Maintenance Project

Applicant: County of Stanislaus

Location: Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 022-004-001 and 047-037-013, near Patterson, Stanislaus County

Description: Stanislaus County, in coordination with the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), proposes to perform maintenance and strengthening work to the East Las Palmas Avenue Bridge over the San Joaquin River. The State Lands Commission action is an amendment of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through June 5, 2043.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 5, 2023, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, County of Stanislaus (County), adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on August 25, 2020. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by the County and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating County's document.
