Project Description: The San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Clean Water Act section 401 water quality certification (Certification No. R9-2022-0034) to the Project Applicant. The Applicant is proposing a combined habitat restoration and hydromodification improvement project within Buena Vista Park. The Buena Vista Park is owned by the City of Vista and managed by the City of Vista Parks and Recreation Department. The Project will establish, restore, and enhance up to 6.53 acres of habitat consisting of wetland, oak riparian, and streambed habitat. In addition, the Project will restore and enhance up to 4.36 acres of upland buffer habitat consisting of coastal sage scrub, coast live oak woodland, and native grassland.

This is to advise that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region, a Responsible Agency, has approved the above-described project on August 20, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project.

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
