Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Skunk Creek in the City of Galt, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.291533, Longitude -121.282884 (decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 148-1100-006-0000. The project is generally located just north of the intersection of Marengo Road and Twin Cities Road.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-29778-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Towne Development of Sacramento, Inc. as represented by Jeff Pemstein.

The project is limited to residential development and associated infrastructure of the 58-acre site. Project development will occur in accordance with the South Sacramento Habitat Conservation Plan (SSHCP). The project includes the following components: mass grading and construction of a water quality/detention basin.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement for the project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
