A Site Approval application to expand an existing activated carbon storage and distribution facility. The project includes a 4,250 square foot expansion of an existing 6,785 square foot warehouse to be used for storage of activated carbon. (Use Type: Wholesaling and Distribution – Light)

SJCOG responded to this project referral that the project is subject to the SJMSCP. The applicant has confirmed that he will participate in SJMSCP. With the applicant's participation, the proposed project is consistent with the SJMSCP and any impacts to biological resources resulting from the proposed project will be reduced to a level of less-than-significant.

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works will require the applicant to pay a Water Supply Facilities Impact Mitigation Fee. The Water Impact Mitigation Fee Program was established to finance San Joaquin County's share of the construction cost for the New Melones Water Conveyance Project, which is intended to mitigate the impact of ground and surface water depletion resulting from new development within the fee area.
