**PROJECT TITLE:** Prescribed Fire in Vernal Pool Management Area

**LOCATION:** Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area **COUNTY:** Sacramento

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Conduct prescribed burning on the 180-acre Vernal Pool Management areas within Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area, in partnership with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (Cal-Fire), to train seasonal firefighters or burn crews from Cal-Fire and/or California State Parks and to reduce thatch cover of non-native vegetation including medusahead and yellow star thistle. Prescribed fire operations may occur in May/June and October/November. Work will:

- Utilize water trucks and Type III fire engines during firing operations to help control and direct prescribed fire;
- Use black lines around areas to be burned and burn in strips or blocks;
- Stage fire trucks and engines along roads and not in the vernal pool areas; and
- As needed, use buffers to protect vernal pools, seasonal wetlands or other sensitive resources and use hand tools to create narrow fire lines ("scratch lines") in selected areas.

Any use of heavy equipment will be conducted under the supervision of a State Park Environmental Scientist.


