Project Description:	To allow for the recordation and development of a 135-lot single-family residential subdivision (Vesting Tentative Tract Map 20275) with 7,200 sq. ft. minimum size lots, on an approximately 40-acre building site that is vacant and undeveloped with an approximate density of 3.4 units per acre.	
Project Location:	Southeast corner of Monte Vista Road and Luna Road; APN: 3133-111-01; Within the City of Victorville, County of San Bernardino, State of California, San Bernardino Meridian, Section 29, Township 5N, Range 5W.
