Project Location (include county): The project is located at the intersection of Los Verjeles Road and South Honcut Creek, in the County of Yuba, State of California; Latitude 39.367980° N, Longitude -121.372068° W; Assessor's Parcel Number 056-260-017-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YUB-43592-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Yuba County Public Works.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of a bridge structure over South Honcut Creek, including the installation of a temporary trestle. The existing bridge will be removed during the installation of the new bridge. Retaining walls and rock slope protection installation are proposed along both the north and south abutments.
