Project Title:

Transfer of land coverage rights to re-construct a new single-family residence.

Project Location – Specific:

The receiving parcel is 7305 Antelope Way (El Dorado County Assessment Number 014-324-008), located in the Westlake Village Subdivision on the west shore of Lake Tahoe.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project consists of the transfer of 803 square feet of potential land coverage rights from Conservancy-owned land to the receiving parcel, identified above, on which a private residence burned down, and will be replaced. The transfer enables the receiving landowner to reconstruct a single family residence without any net increase in the amount of existing land coverage in the Lake Tahoe Basin.

The reconstructed single-family residence will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
