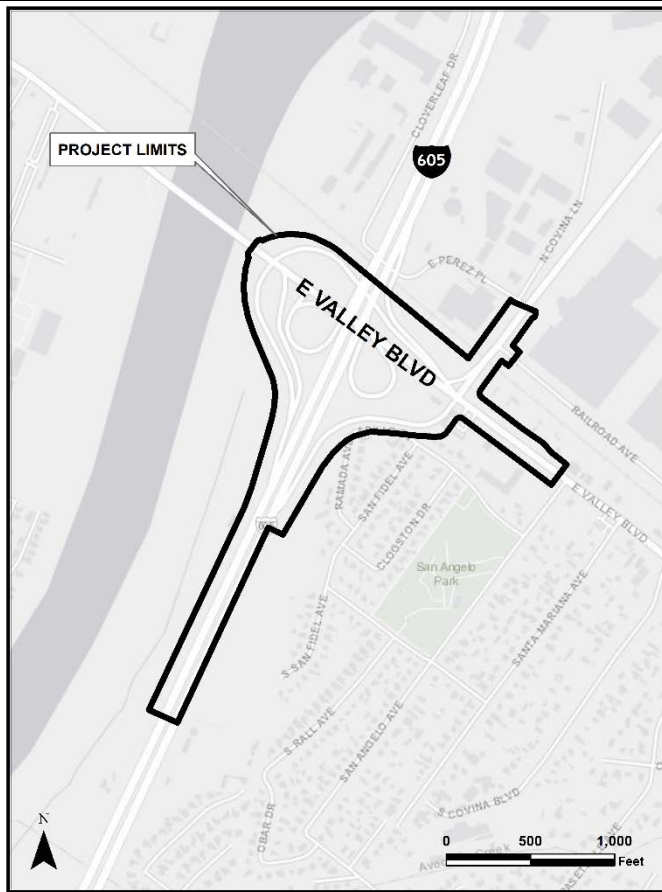




## PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Availability Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration/Environmental Assessment for the Interstate 605/Valley Boulevard Interchange Improvement Project  
and  
Opportunity for a Public Hearing



### WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LA Metro), San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (SGVCOG), Gateway Cities Council of Governments (GCCOG), Los Angeles County Department of Public Works (LACDPW), and City of Industry, has completed the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration/Environmental Assessment (IS/EA) for the Interstate 605 (I-605)/Valley Boulevard Interchange Improvement Project (project). The proposed project is located approximately two miles north of State Route 60 (SR-60) and 0.8 of a mile south of Interstate 10 (I-10) within portions of the City of Industry and unincorporated Los Angeles County. The project would improve mobility and relieve congestion, capacity constraints, and other related deficiencies on Interstate 605 (I-605) at the Valley Boulevard interchange.

### WHY THIS NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects that the proposed project may have on the environment and community. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The results of these studies are contained in the IS/EA. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public of its completion and availability to any interested individual, and to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the project.
