Project Title: Greenstone Country Ongoing Maintenance for Dam and Culverts (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0050-R2).

Project Location: The project is located within the boundaries of the Greenstone Country Community Services District in El Dorado County; within the Shingle Springs USGS quadrangle.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0050-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Greenstone Country Homeowners Association as represented by Sierra Christian.

The Agreement covers routine maintenance of the 101 culverts located within the boundaries of the Greenstone Country Community Services District as well as Indian Creek Reservoir, Picnic Lake, and Gymkhana Lake. Routine maintenance activities covered include removal of sediment, debris, and other obstructions from culverts and removal of cattails and other emergent vegetation from the weirs and spillways of Indian Creek Reservoir, Picnic Lake, and Gymkhana Lake.
