**Title:** PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP PURSUANT SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE AND SECTION 6210.3 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE – A2029

**Location:** Sovereign land in the Pacific Ocean between Big Sycamore Canyon and Point Sand Dune, near Point Mugu State Park, Ventura County.

**Description:** Authorize a Public Agency Permit and approve a Right-of-Way Map as submitted by the California Department of Transportation pursuant to section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code and as authorized by section 6210.3 of the Public Resources Code, effective June 23, 2020, for continuous use plus 1 year, for the use and maintenance of a right-of-way for highway purposes of a portion of Pacific Coast Highway, near Point Mugu.
