**Project Title:** City of Rocklin Routine Maintenance Agreement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0345-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located within the City of Rocklin boundaries. The watercourses included within this Agreement include the following streams and their tributaries: Secret Ravine, Sucker Ravine, Clover Valley Creek, Antelope Creek, and Pleasant Valley Creek.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0345-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Rocklin, as represented by Richard Lawrence.

The Project includes the routine maintenance activities and culvert replacement in several streams and tributaries within the City of Rocklin. Routine maintenance activities will include the removal of debris and obstructions, sediment removal, vegetation control in channels, tree trimming, repair of existing erosion control works, temporary water diversions, and bridge washing, graffiti removal, and painting.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
