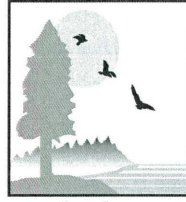

Title: California Coastal Commission Permit 1-15-0277 and Amendment 1-15-0277-A1; California State Lands Commission Project Title: GENERAL LEASE- RIGHT-OF-WAY USE - Leases 7760.1 and 7797.1

Proponent: Mercer-Fraser Company

Location: Sovereign land in the Eel River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Number 200-341-005, 106-041-015, 200-352-006, and 200-352-009, near Fortuna, Humboldt County.

Description: Continued annual placement, use, and removal of two seasonal bridge crossings. The exact location of the bridge may vary from year to year within the lease premises due to conditions in the Eel River. The State Lands Commission action is approval of two 5-year General Lease – Right-of-Way Use through December 31, 2025.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on June 23, 2020, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A substitute document prepared under a certified state regulatory program was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251).
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

Environmental analysis document (Coastal Development Permit #1-15-0277 and amendment 1-15-0277-A1) was granted on September 9, 2016, for this project by the California Coastal Commission (CCC) under its certified program (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251, subd. (c)). The State Lands Commission has reviewed and considered the information therein, concurred with the CCC's determination, and used the CCC document as a substitute Negative Declaration equivalent under CEQA. At this time, the Commission's offices are closed to the public due to public health and safety concerns regarding the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).
