Project Title: Boat Launch Access Point Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0090-R2).

Project Location: The project is located along the Yuba River, a tributary to the Feather River, in the County of Yuba, State of California; Latitude 39.2085 N, Longitude 121.4441 W, in the Southwest quarter of Section 29, Township 16N, Range 5E, in the Browns Valley 7.5-minute U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quadrangle map; Mt. Diablo, base and meridian; Assessor's Parcel Number 006-160-010-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0090-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Tailwater Fisheries, LLC., as represented by Randall Jarvis.

The project is limited to the removal of approximately 70 cubic yards of gravel along the Yuba River, and the placement of approximately 25 cubic yards of new gravel to create a 12' x 155' boat access ramp. The project will be restoring an existing approximately 1,860 square foot gravel boat access ramp.
