The Big Bear area is heavily reliant on its recreational land uses and tourism, particularly the skiing season. The proposed project would perform construction on only one direction of travel at a time, such that traffic may be redirected around the work area while remaining on State Route 18. During the heavy tourist season, performing this work would be controversial, therefore the project proposes to avoid construction during those times wherever feasible.
