The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has reviewed the Negative Declaration (ND) dated June 22, 2020, for the above-referenced project (Project). The Department's review of this Project is pursuant to our role as the State's trustee and responsible agency for fish and wildlife resources under the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. The Project proposes to construct "a self-storage mini warehouse project consisting of 62,275 square feet of storage in nine buildings with a manager's office and on-site residence along with outdoor recreational vehicle storage." The Project is located at 2615 and 2655 Larkspur Lane.

Based on the information provided and Department review, we have no comments at this time. If the Project description changes in any way or additional biological resource information becomes available, the Department should be notified and provided an opportunity to offer comments regarding the updated information.
