The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has reviewed the Negative Declaration (ND) dated June 22, 2020, for the above-referenced project (Project). The Department's review of this Project is pursuant to our role as the State's trustee and responsible agency for fish and wildlife resources under the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. The Project proposes to construct "five industrial buildings consisting 8,680 square feet each (6,000 square feet of warehouse space and 2,680 square feet of office space)." The Project is located at 3950 Rancho Road and has been used for many years as a contractor's storage yard for equipment and storage.

Based on the information provided and Department review, we have no comments at this time. If the Project description changes in any way or additional biological resource information becomes available, the Department should be notified and provided an opportunity to offer comments regarding the updated information.
