Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration for the Arcata 101 Merge Improvement Project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to extend the State Route (SR) 299 entrance ramp to Giuntoli Lane exit on northbound U.S. Highway 101 from postmile 88.3 to postmile 88.6 in Humboldt County. The purpose of this project is to improve merging movements from westbound SR 299 to northbound U.S. 101.
