Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0165-R2, (2-19EX-01649-PLU)

Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Wallace Creek and an off-channel spring which are tributaries to Slate Creek, in Plumas County, State of California. The project is located at Township 21N, Range 09E, at Section 10 and Township 22N, Range 09E, Section 35 on the La Porte U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map, Mount Diablo base and meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0165-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Soper Company.

The project is limited to the use of two existing water drafting sites for the purposes of dust abatement and road maintenance for timber operations.
