Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Delta Field Division (DFD) staff will perform maintenance to re-establish the access route from Bethany Reservoir State Recreation Area to the weir site. The total area for maintenance is approximately 0.2 acres. DFD staff will use an industrial mower on established pathways, hand tools and weed whackers to remove vegetation within the project footprint to maintain the weir efficacy for monitoring purposes. No in water vegetation removal will occur. Removed vegetation will be disposed of at an offsite facility. All equipment staging will be located along the paved roadway. All work is within DWR right of way.
