PROJECT TITLE: Statewide Emergency Caches

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Place and install a prewired cargo container in the maintenance yard at Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park for emergency evacuation of collections and/or for disaster recovery. Work will:

- Install a 20' long x 8' wide x 8.5' high cargo container;
- Install shelving and emergency response evacuation equipment within container;
- Using a backhoe and hand tools excavate a 32' long x 12" wide x 24" deep trench between existing electrical at the maintenance shop and the container;
- Install the electrical conduit and pull the necessary electrical lines to container;
- Backfill the trench with excavated dirt and connect the electrical services; and
- Install climate control to prevent degradation of material.
