Project Location (include county): State Route (SR) 37 postmile 0.0 to postmile R7.4 in Solano County, and SR 37 postmile 2.9 to postmile 6.2 and SR 121 postmile 0.0 to postmile 0.2 in Sonoma County.

Project Description: Reconfigure the existing SR 37 highway lanes from west of the SR 121 intersection to the Walnut Avenue Overcrossing at Mare Island. The project would widen the Tolay Creek Bridge; have four lanes (two full-time lanes in each direction); have 8-foot shoulders (except at Sonoma Creek Bridge, which would have 4-foot shoulders); and would widen the Sonoma Creek Bridge. In each direction the existing lane would be converted to a full-time High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane and the added lane would be a toll lane, in Solano and Sonoma Counties.
