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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project is located at the CAL FIRE Squaw Valley Fire Station located at 25627 Auberry Road, Clovis, California, 93619. The property is characterized as oak woodland and native/non-native grasses in a rural residential area. The project involves the installation of a DG60-2 Caterpillar generator and a new propane tank to provide electrical power to the facility in the event of a power outage. An 11'-4" x 17'-4" concrete footing will be poured to provide a level foundation for the generator. Minor trenching will be completed at lineal distances of approximately 100 feet or less at a depth of 30 inches to connect the propane tank to the generator and then the generator to the station electrical system.
