Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project will rehabilitate the drinking water intakes at Lost Creek, Manzanita Creek, East Hat Creek, and Forest Creek. Work will consist of the removal of all existing leach rock, infiltration pipe and settling tanks. New replacement perforated infiltration pipe will be installed under the filter bed (if required). New, twice-washed leach rock will be installed over the infiltration pipe.
