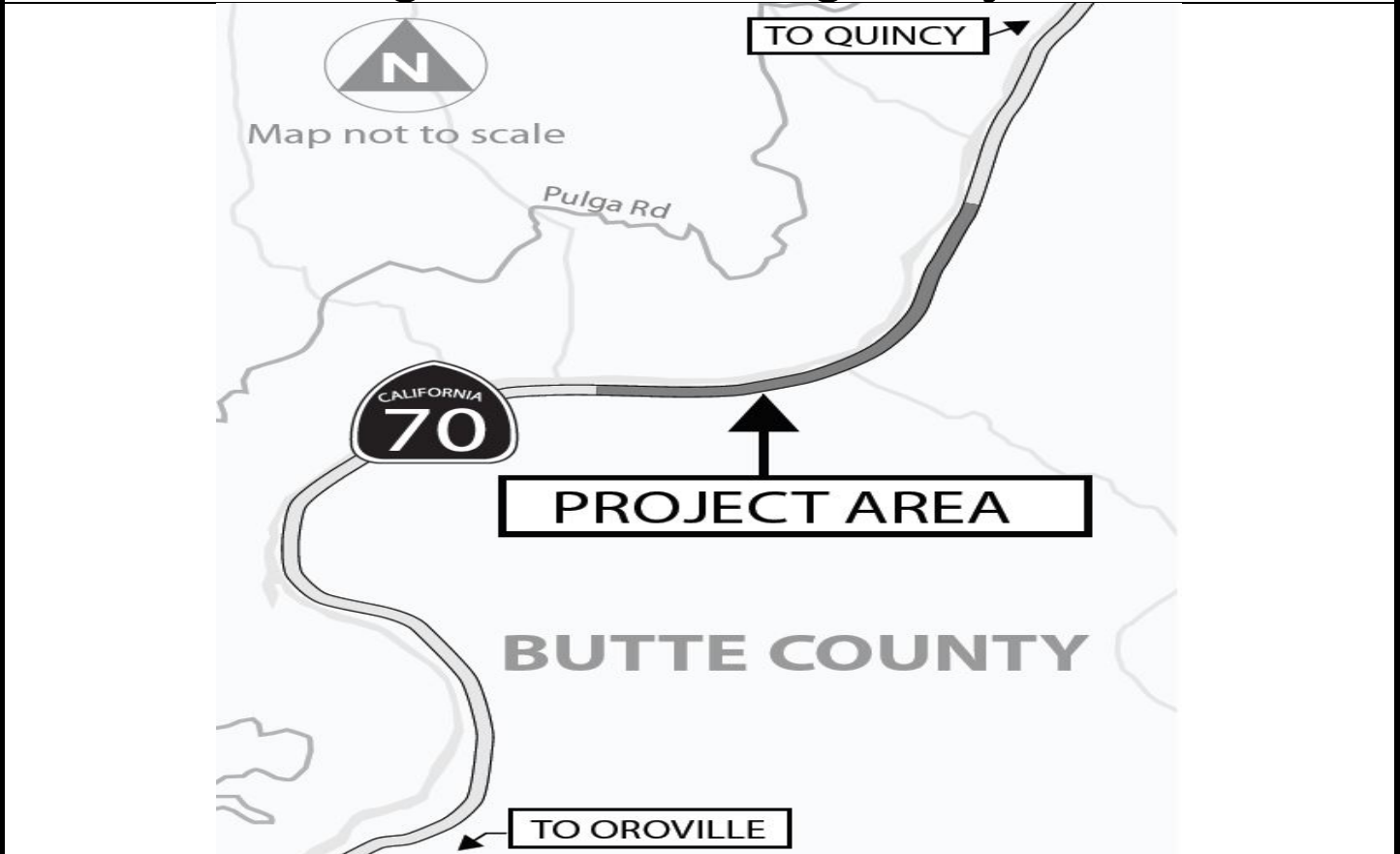




PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Availability of the Draft Environmental Document

Pulga Profile Change Project



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to improve a damaged section of roadway on State Route 70 in Butte County between Post Miles (PM) 46.0 and 47.0 by raising the existing roadway profile approximately 5 feet, replacing the Bear Ranch Creek Bridge (No. 12 0039) at PM 46.40, protecting the embankment with Rock Slope Protection, and placing an earth retaining structure to protect against future flood damage.

WHY THIS NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment with proposed avoidance, minimization, and mitigation measures. This notice is provided to inform the public of the availability of the Draft IS/MND for review and comment.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

The environmental document, referred to as the Initial Study (IS)/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) will be available for review from **July 24, 2020 to August 22, 2020**.
