**Project Title:** Placer Dalby West Routine Maintenance (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0063-R2).

**Project Location:** The project is located within the County of Placer, approximately five (5) miles south of Wheatland. The project occurs within Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 019-290-045-000 and 019-110-035-000, in Sections 15, 22, and 27, Township 13N, Range 5E, USGS quad 'Sheridan', Mt. Diablo Base & Meridian.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0063-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Farm Management Services, as represented by David Evers.

Routine maintenance work, as described in this Agreement, includes vegetation removal and management using an excavator and/or boom mower within two agricultural canals and on the banks of Yankee Slough, and sediment removal from the agricultural canals using an excavator.
