Project Location: The Project is located at 7824 Bollea Road where it crosses over Bear Creek, County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 38.19338, Longitude -120.982578; Section 16, Township 04N, Range 09E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Wallace, Mount Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-21341-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, San Joaquin County Department of Public Works.

The Project is limited to the replacement of the existing Bollea Road bridge over Bear Creek. The new bridge will measure 67 feet by 20 feet and will be installed in the same location as the existing 56 feet by 19 feet bridge. The existing bridge is currently not safe for vehicular traffic, which has resulted in a temporary emergency culvert crossing installation. The emergency crossing will be removed after the new bridge has been installed.
