Project Location/City/County: The Project is located along the west bank of the Sacramento River just upstream of the existing Sacramento Weir at the junction of the Sacramento River and the Sacramento Bypass in Yolo County, California.

Project Description: The Sacramento Weir Widening Project includes construction of an approximately 1,500-foot-long passive weir with the associated levee, roadway, and fish passage improvements. The purpose of the Project is to lower the flood stage in the Sacramento River downstream of the weir during high-flow events to support the broader purpose of reducing flood risk to the Sacramento metropolitan area.

This is to advise that the CVFPB, as the **Lead Agency**, approved the above described project on August 27, 2021 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
