Project Title: Ever Bloom Farms DBA (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-NEV-10222-R2)

Project Location: The project is located in unnamed tributaries of Clear Creek, in the County of Nevada, State of California; Section 33, Township 18N, Range 8E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quad map Camptonville, MDB&M.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has issued Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-NEV-10222-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Daniel Becker.

The Project is limited to grading approximately 11,500 square feet of previously undisturbed land, with approximately 1,600 cubic feet of cut and 1,600 cubic feet of fill. In addition to the grading a new 2-inch PVC water line will be trenched across an unnamed tributary to Clear Creek.

All activity will occur while the existing tributaries and drainages are dry.
