**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0218-R2, Bucks Lake Timber Harvesting Plan 2-20-00094-PLU, PG&E.

Project Location: The project is located within the boundaries of a timber harvesting plan approximately 13 miles west of Quincy within the Rainbow Point and Haskins Valley Planning Watersheds. These watersheds are tributary to Bucks Creek and are within the Feather River Hydrologic Unit located in Plumas County, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Bucks Lake; Township 23N, Range 7E, Section 3, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The project is limited to installation of a permanent crossing (Map Point #5) utilizing a 30-inch corrugated metal pipe (CMP). Further information can be found in the THP 2-20-00094-PLU.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
