Project Title: 8800 Geysers Rd illegal cannabis cultivation remediation (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. 11986-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to Big Sulphur Creek, in the County of Sonoma, State of California; Latitude 38.83067, Longitude -122.89733; 8800 Geysers Road, Cloverdale, CA, 95425; Assessor's Parcel Number 117-220-025.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. 11986-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Ann Tung.

The project is limited to remediating site conditions that are in violation of Fish and Game Code. Generally, the work includes abandoning and restoring stream channels where water diversion was occurring, cleaning up trash and various areas of deleterious substances.
