
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0117-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Tyson Hewitt.

The project is limited to the culvert replacement at watercourse crossing X2 within the 1-19-00203 SCR Hewitt Timber Harvest Plan.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 17, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
