Project Title: Lower College of Marin Corte Madera Creek Restoration Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, EPIMS No. MAN-17829-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Corte Madera Creek, in the census-designated place of Kentfield, in unincorporated Marin County. The Project is adjacent to 99 Stadium Way, Kentfield, CA 94904 and spans from immediately downstream of the Stadium Way pedestrian bridge to the downstream end of the existing concrete-lined channel. The project is located approximately at Latitude 37.95274°N, Longitude 122.54595°W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. MAN-17829-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, as represented by Joanna Dixon.

The project is limited to restoration of wetland, intertidal, and aquatic habitat; bank stabilization; installation of storm water treatment features; and installation of a concrete wall.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 9/27/2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
