RESOLUTION NO. 08-20-04

Resolution of Energy Efficiency Loan

Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District

WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission provides loans to schools, hospitals, local governments, special districts, and public care institutions to finance energy efficiency improvements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the board of the Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District authorizes Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District to apply for an energy efficiency loan from the California Energy Commission to implement energy efficiency measures.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Board of the Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District (Governing Body) finds that the activity funded by the loan is exempt from further CEQA evaluation under Class 11, Class 14, and Class 29 categorical exemptions of the California Code of Regulations Title 14 Chapter 13 as well as CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2.


BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that if recommended for funding by the California Energy Commission, the Board of the Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District authorizes Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District to accept a loan up to \$690,508.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that the amount of the loan will be paid in full, plus interest, under the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement and Promissory Note of the California Energy Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of Monson-Sultana Joint Union Elementary School District all necessary documents to implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution, and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the energy efficiency projects.
