Disturbed areas due to unauthorized access will be decompacted with hand tools, and erosion control logs will be placed to provide slope stabilization and reduce erosion. This project aims to protect and restore the natural resources on Conservancy land.

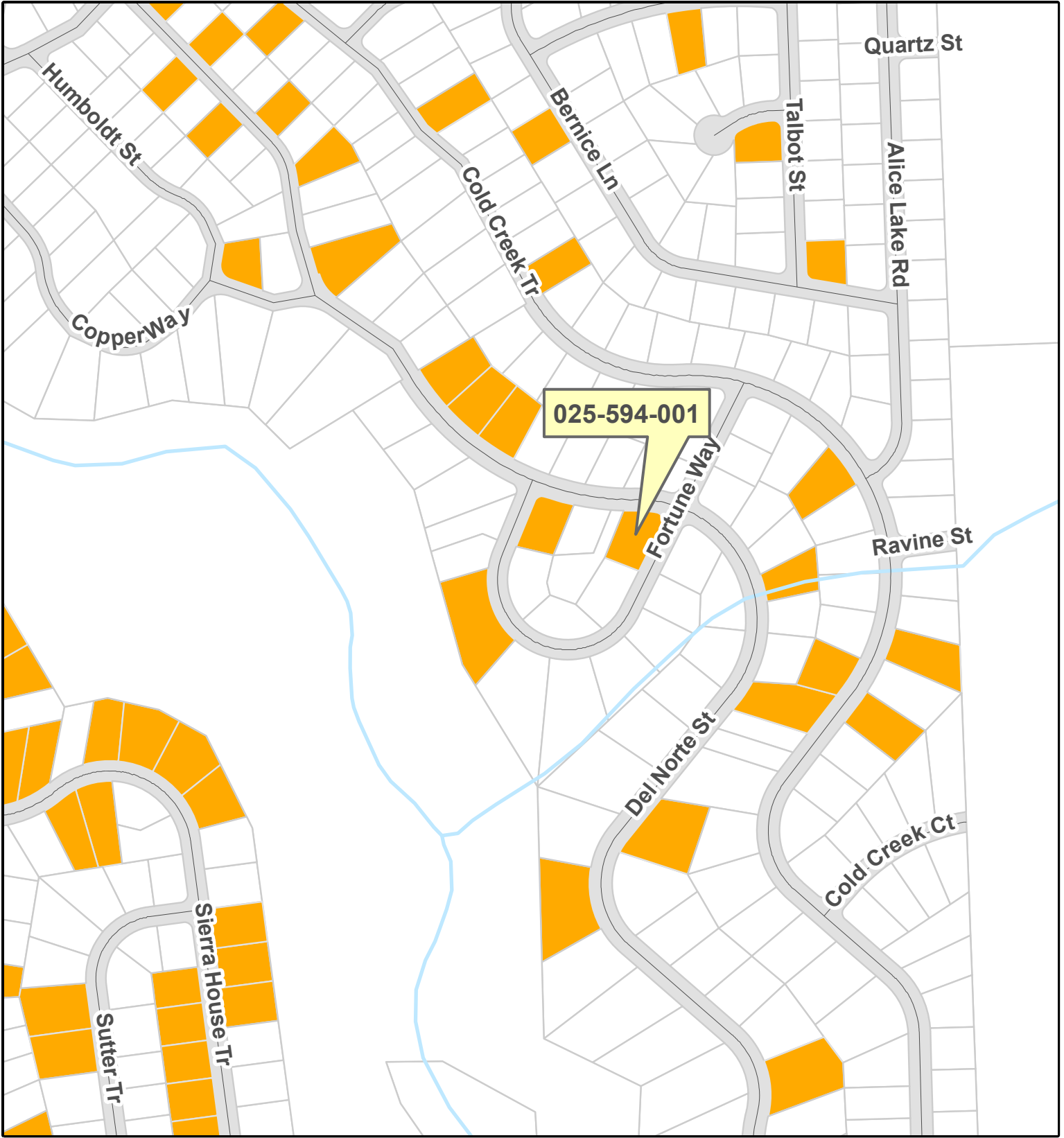

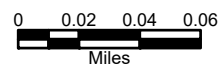
