Project Title: Los Trancos Creek Restoration (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0374-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Los Trancos Creek, in the County of San Mateo, State of California; Latitude 37.356356 Longitude -122.206688, 11 Buck Meadow Drive, Portola Valley, CA 94028; Assessor’s Parcel Number [080-241-270].

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0374-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to The Klein/ Guttman Trust as represented by Bob Klein.

The unnamed tributary on the project site was impacted by a landscape crew performing vegetation trimming and removal. Vegetation was removed in close proximity to the stream, which has led to excess sediment deposition. Additionally, 18.5 cubic yards of soil was displaced by heavy equipment. This agreement covers restoration activities to address impacts to the unnamed stream.

To address impacts to the stream, the activities to restore the stream will include grading and recontouring the stream back to its original configuration and revegetating the site with planting vegetation. The 18.5 cubic yards of displaced soil will remain onsite but will be removed from the stream. This material will be used to recontour the stream back to its condition pre-disturbance.


