Project Title: Hristov Crossing Maintenance Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0295-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project site is located at 281 N. Meadow Lane, in the town of Hayfork in Trinity County; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 015-420-31-00.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0295-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mr. Chris Hristov.

The Streambed Alteration Agreement includes the upgrade and maintenance of an existing culvert located on an unnamed tributary to Barker Creek. Work will include clearing sediment and debris from the inlet and outlet of the culvert and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
